

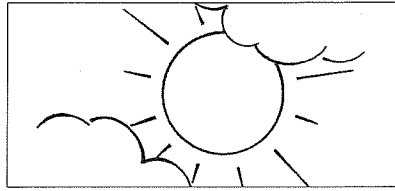
Instructors can:

- show two weather words and ask learners to write the correct one in the blank.

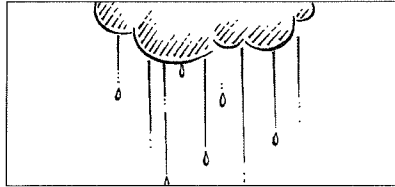
Learners can:

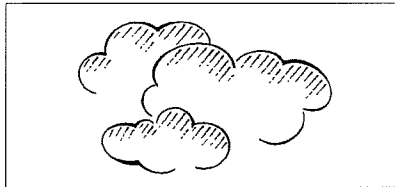

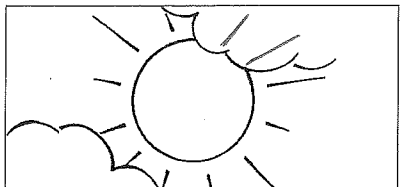

Learners can:

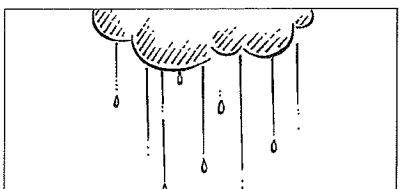
- circle the weather word that is the same as the picture.

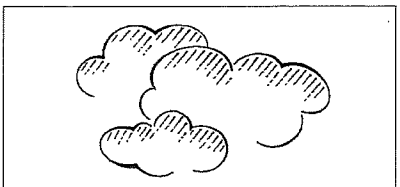

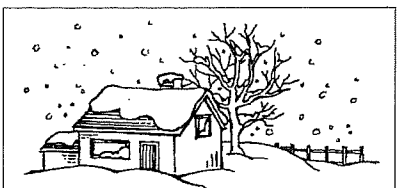
